How To Enroll...

Participants must submit a completed application along with the following:

- \$50 entry fee, this is nonrefundable- Must be submitted at the time of application OR at orientation
- current grade card

Miss JuneteenthKC Application Scholarship---*Each Miss JuneteenthKC participant is offered the opportunity to submit a two-minute video detailing how receiving an application scholarship will support them in achieving their goal to become Miss JuneteenthKC and what it would mean to them to represent their community if they are crowned. The video must include their name, age, and current school.*

Official Participant Rules:

- An application must be completed and submitted with a current report card.
- The application **must** be signed by a parent or guardian before participating.
- Program dates and rehearsals are mandatory!
Please contact coordinators if conflicts arise.
- **All Miss JuneteenthKC participants will participate in eight themed workshops hosted Saturday from 9:00-1:00 pm (student check-in @ 8:45 am) March 18th-May 13th focused on history, advocacy, service, etiquette, and education.**
Extracurricular Activity Attendance Waiver-- Participants unable to attend workshops due to enrollment in another extracurricular activity will be permitted to be excused from attending activities on March 25th, April 1st, April 8th. Participants MUST attend all other workshop dates and must attend a supplemental workshop offered during the week OR alternate educational assignment must be completed/submitted the week of their absence.
- Participants must not have legal pending issues.

- All waivers and consents will be required to be submitted before April 8th.
- Contestants must attend ALL dress rehearsals.
- Application fees are nonrefundable.
- Participants must wear their pageant sash while conducting JKC pageant business.
- At all times, contestants, parents, and guests are required to display positive attitudes!
- All decisions from the judging panel are final. —Score cards can be provided to review upon request

Lil Miss JuneteenthKC Participants will receive an automatic 10 points for completing the group opening dance. Miss JuneteenthKC (16-18) will be judged and scored based on a 2-minute talent performance.

The Sweetest Peach (Team Unity Award)—This award will be given to the participant that has been selected by 2023 Miss JuneteenthKC Pageant class to be the most uplifting and motivational pageant participant.

TOTAL 100

The points from all participants score cards will be calculated, and the Top Five scores will dictate the top 5 finalists. A top finalist will be selected to be crowned from the Lil Miss & Miss JuneteenthKC pageant groups. Only the crowned participant from the Miss JuneteenthKC pageant group will be registered to compete at the National competition in Galveston, TX.

Ticket & Ad Sales-

While ticket and Ad Sales IS NOT MANDATORY to participate in the Miss JuneteenthKC Pageant program. Incentives & awards are offered to the top 3 advertisement/ticket sellers. —The contestant that sells the highest amount of money will be acknowledged during the pageant presentation event and a special award.

PAGEANT WORKSHOPS

Miss JuneteenthKC participants will participate in eight themed workshops beginning March 18th. Each workshop will be focused on history, advocacy, service, etiquette, and education.

Pageant participants will learn the history of Juneteenth, the Historic 18th and Vine Jazz District, and other significant moments in Kansas City's Black history. Participants will be engaged in community conversations to understand the importance of advocating for causes and how to advocate for change within their community. Service to the community and others will be paramount in becoming Miss JuneteenthKC; and participants will be given the opportunity to develop healthy social relationships in addition to acquiring the etiquette skills needed to excel in life.

Pageant mentors will provide engaging workshops to share personal insights that will guide each participant as they begin their journey into young adulthood.

Our Miss JuneteenthKC participants will not only achieve skills but be ready to influence their peers intentionally, represent our community, and serve Kansas City!

Gowns

Pageant gowns will be provided by the Natalie M. Studio for all pageant participants. Participants are required to attend a dress selection/fitting session. **–April 4th & April 6th 5:00-8:00 pm--** Once a participant has made their dress selection an appointment will be scheduled for alterations. Dresses will be held by JuneteenthKC and will be provided for the participants during their photo shoots/pageant presentation day.

Participants will be provided with makeup artists the day of the photo shoot and the pageant presentation day.



Parental Consent and Release

AUTHORIZATION, WAIVER OF LIABILITY & INDEMNITY AGREEMENT MEDICAL and MEDIA RELEASE

In Consideration of being permitted, at my specific request, for me or my child/ward to participate in the activity, we HEREBY RELEASE, WAIVE, DISCHARGE, AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE the Miss JuneteenthKC Pageant, it's officers, volunteers, and agents, individually or in an official capacity for the group (all for purposes herein referred to as "releases") from all liabilities, claims, actions, damages, costs or expenses which we may have against any of the releases arising out of or in any way connected to participation in the activity, including , travel to or from the activity, for bodily injury, death or property damage suffered by me/my child before, during, or after said activity. I understand that this release and waiver includes any claim or action based on the negligence, action or inaction of any release or otherwise.

I HEREBY ASSUME FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR AND RISK OF BODILY INJURY, DEATH, OR PROPERTY DAMAGE due to the negligence of releases or otherwise while engaged in or as a result of the activity. I expressly acknowledge and agree that the activity may involve the risk of injury or property damage.
